Investing in your gas supply

Broughton Street area Edinburgh









We're investing £500,000 to upgrade our gas network in the Broughton Street area of Edinburgh.

This essential project involves replacing our old gas mains with new plastic pipe to ensure a continued safe and reliable gas supply for the local area for many years to come.

We've worked closely with the local authorities in planning our project. Our work will begin on Monday 7 January 2019 and take around 26 weeks to complete.

We'll be working in Broughton Street between York Place and the roundabout for London Street/East London Street for approximately 12 weeks. The road will be closed to northbound traffic and parking restrictions will be in place.

We will then be working in London Street and Forth Street, and parking restrictions will be in place. During our work in Forth Street, the road will be closed in two separate sections. Motorists will be required to follow signed diversion routes.
