

# SGN Third Party Connections Briefing Note 21

## (Guidance on Care-of iGT submissions)

### 1 Introduction

As per the Gas Industry Registration Scheme (*GIRS*), Utility Infrastructure Providers (*UIPs*) can act on behalf of an Independent Gas Transporter (*iGT*) to facilitate submissions that the adopting iGT will own upon completion.

### 2 Criteria

UIPs registered as '*Agents of*' for iGTs, depending on their level of GIRS accreditation can undertake the following:

- Process land enquiries on behalf of the adopting iGT
- Request Connection Quotations on behalf of the adopting iGT
- Accept any quotation on behalf of the adopting iGT
- Process Routine / Non-Routine Operations on behalf of the adopting iGT
- Process Routine / Non-Routine Operations <2bar on behalf of the adopting iGT
- Process Routine / Non-Routine Operations <7bar on behalf of the adopting iGT
- Process Closure Packs for the Connection onto Scotia Gas Network's parent main on behalf of the adopting iGT

The UIP acting on behalf of the adopting iGT will be responsible for all aspects of the Safe Control of Operations (*SCO*).

The adopting iGT should promote the '*Agent of*' contract to SGN for each UIP that they wish to undertake works on their behalf, an example of such a contract is available on request.
